<p>Unit Theme: Review: Louisiana and Animal Habitats</p>	<p>March 7-8, 2019</p> 	
<p>Language Arts/Reading <u>Phonemic Awareness</u> – Students will continue to blend sounds together to make new words and segment all sounds in words. We will focus some on rhyming to review. <u>Phonics</u> – Students will blend letters to read CVC, CCVC and CVCC words. Review sounds and sight words listed below. Working with reading and writing double letter sounds: ll, mm, rr, tt, ss, etc. <u>Literature</u> – Students will explore answering the question: What are symbols of Louisiana? <u>Writing</u> – Students will practice writing informational and narrative pieces, using criteria they created for exceptional writing.</p>	<p>Things to work on at home with your child:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Write name (capital and lowercase) first and last -Count to 100 by ones and 100 by 10s <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Read with your child every night - Draw a picture of at least two sentences on the back of the paper -Practice writing numbers 0-20 in increasing and decreasing order -Practice writing all letters, capital and lowercase -Use conventions of print when writing -Practice all sight words nightly
