Language Arts/Reading

<u>Phonemic Awareness</u> — Students will listen to tell how many words are in a sentence.

<u>Phonics</u> - Students will ID letters in their names.

<u>Literature</u> — Students will explore answering the question: How does reading help us learn? Students will look at pictures and use text clues to explore a fictional story.

<u>Writing</u> — Students will practice writing their names with a capital letter at the beginning and lowercase throughout.

Things to work on at home with your child:

Practice writing your name
Counting to 20 by ones
Read with your child every night
Practice tying your shoes and tucking in your shirt

Math

Students will identify items that are exactly the same or slightly different and sort objects into categories. Students will describe HOW they sorted.

Social Studies/Science

Students will create a list of rules that are important for our classroom and discuss how to follow those rules. Students will also explore the weather and how it affects our daily choices.
