Unit Theme:

Applying our Knowledge of our 5 Senses to our World

Language Arts/Reading

<u>Phonemic Awareness</u> — Students will continue to blend sounds together to make new words.

<u>Phonics</u> — Students will ID m, a, t, d by sound. We will continue to focus on left and right tracking. We will learn the sight words the, of, I this week, as well!

<u>Literature</u> — Students will explore answering the question: How do our senses help us learn? Students will look at pictures and use text clues to explore a fictional text. We will continue to answer prompts using text evidence to support answers.

<u>Writing</u> — Students will practice using response journals to answer sentence prompts. We will focus on adding a label to drawings.

Math

Students will count groups to tell how many and will learn to form the numbers 8, 9 and 10.

Social Studies/Science

Students will discuss a community and what that means, What types of places are found within a community and what the different types of communities are: rural, urban and suburban. We will discuss the water cycle and how it affects our weather and our world.


