

<p>Unit Theme: Exploring Our World With Our 5 Senses</p>	<p>September 3-7, 2018 <u>THE 5 SENSES</u></p> 
<p>Language Arts/Reading</p> <p><u>Phonemic Awareness</u> – Students will listen to tell how many words are in a sentence or phrase. <u>Phonics</u> – Students will ID letters in their names. We will continue to focus on left and right. <u>Literature</u> – Students will explore answering the question: How do our senses help us learn? Students will look at pictures and use text clues to explore an informational text. <u>Writing</u> – Students will practice using response journals to answer sentence prompts. We will create a class book about our 5 senses, using text evidence in our writing.</p>	<p>Things to work on at home with your child:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Practice writing your name -Counting to 20 by ones - Read with your child every night - Practice tying your shoes -Practice fastening and unfastening your belt -Practice writing numbers 0-5 -Use the words RIGHT and LEFT as often as possible in daily communication
<p>Math</p> <p>Students will count groups to tell how many and will learn to form the numbers 0-5. Students will tell the parts they see in groups to 5.</p>	<p>TAKE HOME FOLDER</p> <p>Please check your child's folder each night for school information. Any transportation changes should be put in this folder.</p>
<p>Social Studies/Science</p> <p>Students will discuss helpers in our community and what their jobs are. Weather related to seasons will also be discussed and students will sort clothing and other objects that would be best used for a particular season. Students will sequence the seasons</p>
